The **Department of Planning and Regional Development (DPRD)** is the first department in Greece offering an undergraduate professional degree in Planning and Regional Development. The department offers a five-year professional diploma, three master's programmes and a doctorate degree. The Department has established 11 Laboratories providing research facilities in various scientific fields. The European and international dimension of the DPRD is enriched by the participation in a series of research programs with broader European and International content. Furthermore, the EU has assigned the Laboratory of Urban and Regional Planning of the Department as the national focal point of the European Spatial Development Observatory. The laboratory South-East European Development Centre (SEED) is established as an interdisciplinary research and policy analysis centre and intends to contribute to the planning, analysis and evaluation of development policies applied to the less advanced regions of Europe. In this respect, the research teams of SEED aim to approach the development issues in a multi-national and multi-disciplinary way, presenting reports and policy recommendations to appropriate policy bodies, such as international organisations and governments. DPRD is also a member of the Scientific Committee for the Mediterranean - Balkan postgraduate and doctoral program and co-operates with IAM-Montpellier, Hassan II-Rabat and Université de Caïre, under the EU's NECTAR Program. Finally, the University of Thessaly hosts the 3rd cycle of seminars of Mediterranean-Balkan doctoral program specialised in spatial analysis and applied cartography and the Network of Balkan Demographers (DEMOBALK).

**Konstantinos Lalenis** (M.Eng., PhD) is Assistant Professor in the Department of Urban Planning and Development. He graduated from Aristotelion University of Thessaloniki, Greece, as a Civil Engineer. He had his Master's degree in Transportation Planning in the University of Toronto, Canada, and his PhD in Urban Planning in the University of Westminster, London UK. He has work experience in both, the public sector (Greek Ministry of Planning), 1985-1995, and the private sector (private consultant in Transportation and Urban Planning projects), 1995-2008. He has been awarded two Pan-Hellenic urban planning prizes. He also worked as evaluator for the EC for the FP5 programs and participated in various European projects [PLUREL (6<sup>th</sup> FP, 2007-), GreenKeys (INTERREG, 2005 – 2008), RIMED (INTERREG CADSES, 2003 – 2005), TERRA CZM Kavala (2000 – 2003), SDAP (LIFE, 1998 – 2000), RIMES (Transport RTD, 1999 - 2002). Current research interests include participation and governance issues, planning law and institutional frameworks, planning practices, institutional transplantation.
